Due to the government shutdown, and President Trump's refusal to fund it, SNAP/food stamps will not be re-filled in November. However, SNAP members will still have access to HIP (\$40-60-80 depending on household size, can only be used for produce at local farmstands and farmers markets). But you must have at least 1¢ left on your SNAP account to use it.

community fridges and other mutual aid

A community fridge is a fridge located in a public space to allow members of a community to share food with one another. Unlike traditional food pantries, people are encouraged to add to the fridge or take food out according to their individual needs. There are no limits imposed, no ID or paperwork required, and the fridges are typically open 24/7. Donations are provided by food relief programs, community members, businesses and farms with excess food, and anyone else who would like to help. Community fridges are organized by members of each community as an effort of mutual aid; in solidarity rather than charity.
